

Storm Watch:

Storm conditions are possible and anticipated in a specified area within 48 hours. Prepare your facility and review your plan for evacuation in case a Hurricane or Tropical Storm Warning is issued. Listen closely to instructions from local officials.

Storm Warning:

Storm conditions expected and predicted for a specified area within 36 hours. During a warning, complete storm preparations and immediately leave the threatened area if directed to do soby local officials.

Storm Surge:

An abnormal rise of water generated by strong winds. Water level can rise to more than 20 feet and cover hundreds of miles of coast.

Extreme Wind Warning:

Winds of 115 mph or greater expected within the hour. Winds are usually associated with the eyewall of a hurricane or typhoon. Find shelter immediately in the interior of a secure building, preferably in the basement or ground floor.



Games, books, music players

A blanket and sleeping bag for each person



Cellphone and charger with inverter, battery pack or solar charger



Medicine, prescriptions
